Site Safety Summary

HEALTH EVALUATION

Parents must submit the student health screening form on ParentSquare.com prior to arrival at student drop-off. Those who have failed to do so will not be allowed to exit their vehicles.

Student temperatures will be evaluated with a thermal scanner and/or non-touch thermometer upon entry to campus each day. Students with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 will be further evaluated, and may be moved to an isolated area to await parent transportation.

CUSTODIAL CLEANING

All classrooms, offices, restrooms and areas used by students and staff will be cleaned and disinfected twice per day.

STUDENT MOVEMENT

Activities on campus will be scheduled in a way that minimizes the number of students moving on campus at the same time. Students will follow directional signs and stay to the right of common walkways. Classrooms will use assigned routes when moving to specific locations.

GRAB AND GO MEALS

Kitchen operator will prep and deliver Grab and Go meals to classrooms at the end of the cohort session.

STUDENT ENTRY

TK/K arrive front (office) loop temperature station
1/2 arrive at back (field) loop temperature station

**Siblings should travel with the youngest in their family!*

Cohort A: 8:00 am (in their classroom ready to go by 8:15)

Cohort B: 12:10 pm (in their classroom ready to go by 12:25)

STUDENT DISMISSAL

Each classroom will have a designated departure door or gate and route that students will be expected to follow. The doors/ gates/ routes will promote social distancing and limit access to the interior of the building.

Cohort A: 10:40 am - **Cohort B:** 2:50 pm

- 1-2 at back (field) loop

MOVEMENT BREAKS

Each classroom will have a zone on the playground & within each zone will be designated individual student activity areas. Separate equipment for each cohort will be maintained by each classroom & cleaned between use. No shared equipment use between students.

RESTROOMS

Bathrooms will be monitored by campus safety personnel during the school day. Soap, hand sanitizers and paper towels will be available. Handwashing and physical distancing signs will be displayed. TK/K (4 classes) have multiple bathroom options depending on the location of their classroom. 3 classrooms will use upper campus bathrooms, 4 will use lower campus bathrooms.
