The meeting came to order at 1:00pm.

Alternative Education 2019-2020

LVUSD will be launching alternative education centers at both high schools in fall of 2019. The committee discussed the staffing structure, and student identification process. Alternative education will support students in accessing the least restrictive environment, students who need a hybrid schedule, and students in need of credit recovery.

Concurrent/Dual Enrollment

The committee discussed the expansion of the Early College Academy and our ongoing dual enrollment partnership with Moorpark College. Board policy relating to concurrent enrollment at outside institutions was discussed, and staff will revisit the policy with their teams.

Systems of Intervention 2019-2020

The new Community 360 Counseling Center and Alternative Learning Centers are providing Tier-2 supports that can serve as pre-special education interventions. The team discussed the need for clarifying our Tier-1 supports in 2019-2020 with respect to academics and behavior. Pathways will receive an update on these plans in early fall.

Professional Development 2019-2020

The Committee discussed the need to focus professional development in 2019-2020 around core LCAP priorities. This will involve more site-based collaboration around professional learning communities, math/literacy instruction, and classroom behavior. A formal plan will be brought to Pathways in the fall after LVEA-district negotiations this summer.
